The Scholarship Committee is particularly interested in evidence of character, relative maturity, integrity, independence, interests, skills, and any special talents or qualities.

## Information & Tips for Scholarship Applicants

1. DO NOT WAIT TO APPLY
2. The student must be a graduating senior of the 2019-2020 academic school year.
3. Applicants must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
4. The scholarship recipients will be selected by the Chamber Scholarship Foundation Committee.
5. The scholarship must be used for expenses with the requirement that recipient be a full-time student.
6. All required documents must be postmarked by April 6, 2020. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure documents are submitted to the Chamber and are postmarked on or before April 6, 2020 (such as letter of recommendation or transcripts if submitted separately).
7. Each component of the application will be considered in the evaluation. Incomplete applications will not be considered. There shall be no discrimination based on race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, or gender.
8. Scholarship Recipients will be notified by May 11, 2020 through email and a personal letter. Awards will be presented on May 28, 2020 at the Chamber's Celebration of Membership Dinner.
9. Awarded scholarships will be in the amount of \$1,000 each to one male & one female recipient.
